

## A CALL FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Are you interested in sharing your research with your colleagues? This is an excellent opportunity to share the findings of your studies with others and gain practice presenting a poster.

At the 2025 APTA New Mexico Fall Conference, we will have poster presentations from therapists and students on research, special interest, case study, or theory reports. This opportunity is open to all PTs, PTAs and Students with eligible presentations. There is no fee for presenting your poster.

## POSTER PRESENTATIONS - SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2025

During Exhibit Hall Hours 11:15-11:50 am and 1:00-1:30 pm

This is an open time for those in attendance to view the posters, meet the authors, and ask questions. The posters will be assembled in the morning and should be up by 11:00 am. The poster session will end at 1:30 pm. Final details will be provided to those accepted, prior to the Fall Conference.

An abstract of your poster presentation is required by August 15, 2025 and should be sent to info@nmapta.org.

A panel will review your abstract and notification of acceptance will be given by **August 22**, **2025**. Abstracts will be reviewed in the order that they are received.

If you choose to register for the Fall Conference, please note that the registration deadline is August 27, 2025.

There is a 3,125-character limit for the text of your abstract submission which includes spaces, but not authors or institutions. The abstract should use between size 10-12 font with double spacing, and contain the following, based on type of project:
